2010 POST-DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The Institute for Aegean Prehistory (INSTAP) is pleased to announce the availability of one post-doctoral fellowship to be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible candidates for work to be done between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. The year-long fellowship is intended for scholars in the field of the Aegean Bronze Age/Early Iron Age who have received a Ph.D. degree in the past five years, that is, between May, 2004 and August, 2009. The Fellowship will be awarded in the amount of \$24,000, plus up to \$4,000 additional for travel expenses.

Applications must be received in the INSTAP office in Philadelphia no later than **November 1, 2009**, and awards will be announced by February 1, 2010. It is strongly advised that foreign applicants submit their applications by an express courier service (i.e., DHL, UPS, FEDEX). Applications will not be accepted by fax or e-mail.

INSTAP will now accept applications and final reports submitted via **e-mail**. Please send one copy as an attachment, either as an MS WORD document or PDF file to:

The fellowship will be awarded for a specific project and is not renewable.

In addition to the completed application form, proposals should include a *curriculum vitae* of the applicant and two non-confidential letters of support: one from the applicant's sponsor (who should be a senior scholar) and the second from a scholar in the field. If the proposed work is intended to coincide with a leave-of-absence from an academic institution, a letter from the Chair (or comparable official) stating that courses scheduled to be taught by the applicant will be covered by someone with research interest in the Aegean Bronze Age/Early Iron Age should be included. If the applicant is employed, the proposed research should be done during a leave of absence.
